Internet Research Resources

- eBay Favorite Searches
- Google Alerts
- RSS Feeds
- Google Earth

eBay

- Ability to set up alerts
- E-mails you daily when someone is selling an item with your keyword
- Items that may appear
 - Postcards
 - Old Photos
 - Books
 - Letters
 - Stock Certificates

Pros

- You have the ability to collect items on a national scale without having to shop around
- Some items that you may have never thought of will come avaialable

Cons

- This costs money
 - Try not to spend more than \$5.00
 - Don't forget about shipping costs
- You may need access to a scanner
- If you can't afford to spend the money out of your pocket, see if a local society will help or contact the historical museum to see if you could donate the items to them after you have scanned the information
- Some counties will have common names that might bring up other items

Land certificate for Mrs. Isabel Dillman for E.R. Cosby Karnes County 300 Acre Lease Pool

On October 12, 1932, Mrs. Isabel Dillman purchased a portion of land in Karnes County in the E.R. Cosby Karnes County 300 Acre Lease Pool. The certificate starts thusly:

"This certifies that Mrs. Isabel Dillman is the owner of a 1/3000th interest in and to 300 acres oil and gas leases in Karnes County, Texas, described below, and is entitled to his (or her) prorate share of an sale of any properties comprising the E.R. Cosby - Karnes County - 300 Acre Lease Pool being the 7/8th oil and gas leases on THIRTEEN tracts of land comprising 300 acres, as described and of record in Deed Records of Karnes County, Texas..."

In the 1930 census, there was an Isabel Dillman (wife of J. Alex Dillman) living in Milwaukee, Wisconsin (Disctricts 1-250). No record if this is the same person.

In March of 1927, E.R. Cosby is listed as a defendant in a lawsuit regarding the cancellation of a mineral lease in Pottawatomie County in Oklahoma. Source: Hearn vs. Blakeney & Ambrister

- Don't just use the county name as your keyword
 - Do you have cities of import?
 - Do you have local heroes of yore?
 - Did something historical happen in your county?
- Don't get discouraged
 - You may not get many hits on your keywords, but give it time; even one item may add a wonderful facet to your county site


Google Alerts

- Setting up alerts in Google will give you an opportunity to have the search engine scan the web for your keywords
 - Newspaper articles
 - Obituaries and memorials
 - Book reviews
 - County festivals

Newspaper Articles


- This gives you an opportunity to keep your news archives updated
 - This may not seem like much today,
 but think about the person who views
 your archives in 30 years
 - Sometimes this will include notices of wartime deaths which you can then see if you can find an obituary or memorial

Obituaries and Memorials

- Google can send you updates when they find an obituary from your county newspaper
 - Many newspapers update their obituary pages daily, so this usually doesn't happen, but you might get lucky
- Sometimes when someone in your county passes, their family will create a memorial page on that person which might include photos
 - Contact the family and see if they would mind if you posted the photos on your county site

County Festivals

- Most counties have festivals throughout the year
 - These alerts will keep you up-to-date on the festivals
 - Keep in mind that unless the dates are posted very early, you might not be hearing about the events until after the fact
 - You might get some great photos out of these events as well as a history write-up if the festivals are long-running

RSS Feeds

- RSS feeds have really grown in the last year and can give you valuable updates
- You will need to have a Feed Reader
 - Many e-mail programs now support this service
 - My Yahoo or similar portals are great ways to do this, especially if they are your home page

cotton, corn, broom corn, and sorghum. It is not so well adapted to early truck as the sands and sandy loams. Most of the gravelly sandy loam is used for pasture.

The Lufkin series has three types—the sands, which are very limited in extent; the gravelly sandy loam, which is of small agricultural value; and the sandy loams, which are fair general-purpose soils well adapted to the earlier truck crops.

The Susquehanna soils are of limited extent and little agricultural value.

The Duval sandy loams are well adapted to truck crops, cotton, and corn. They are easily worked, maintain moisture well, and are above the average in productiveness. Very little of the Beeville fine sandy loam is under cultivation. Cotton and corn are grown to some extent and a small acreage is planted to vegetables.

The Karnes soils occur along the San Antonio and Cibolo Rivers and are very productive. A small acreage is irrigated, the chief crops being onions and alfalfa. Corn and cotton also do well.

The level coast country is occupied by the soils of the Victoria, Edna, and Lomalta series, and the Nueces and Galveston fine sands. The Victoria series has three types—a fine sandy loam, especially



Employment in the support activities for mining industry had the highest average wages in Karnes County for the 2nd quarter of 2006. The average worker in the industry in Karnes County earned an annual wage of \$41,390 in 2nd quarter of 2006. The wage rate is less than the industry wage in Texas of \$73,362 and less than then the pay for jobs in this industry in the United States of \$64,588.

Other Possible Feeds

- Many newspapers now have RSS feeds built into their websites
 - See if you can get one for the obituaries; it would be a great way to keep up
- Media
 - You might also check your local news stations to see if they offer feeds
- Be sure that you always credit the source of your information!

Cons

- Unless you can set up a feed at a site that specifically keys into your county name(s), this might be cumbersome
 - For instance, the paper for my county is in Victoria, but I can't set up a feed for Karnes County, so I use Google alerts to let me know about news
 - However, I can set up The Portal to Texas History to show me only new items about Karnes, so it works great

Google Earth

- Google Earth is a program that allows you to have topographical photos
- You have to install the program on your computer and you have to have internet access when you are trying to find a new site
 - You can save these sites and view them later without internet access

Why would I use Google Earth?

- If you wanted to give your users an overhead view of directions to a place, like a cemetery, this would be a great addition to textual instructions
- You can also use these to add some nice thumbnail photos to your site


Pros

- It will give you the exact GPS locations
- It will also give you the altitude of a location
- You can use this to find directions to a given location

Cons

- The resolution goes only so far
 - Because these are satelite photos, you can only zoom in to a point
 - You wouldn't be able to zoom in and see a specific tombstone, for instance
- Not all areas are well photographed
 - United States is pretty good, but some of third world countries aren't
- You can't see the forest because of the trees
 - If the place is covered by foliage, you won't be able to see it from above


Example of a Cemetery
